LUANA CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 3, 2022

Meeting at the Luana Fire Department. Location changed due to COVID19 Social Distancing requirements. The Luana City Council held their regular monthly meeting Thursday

February 3, 2022, at 7:00 pm. with Council Members Lonnie Baade. Kevin Boddicker, Todd Olson, Jackie Radloff-Schneider, Luke Steege present. Absent: None.

Mayor Jerry Schroeder called meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Minutes of January meeting were reviewed and approved upon a motion by Radloff-Schneider, second by Steege, carried unanimously. Radloff-Schneider motioned to

pay all monthly claims totaling \$15,132.63, Olson second, car-ried unanimously. Receipts for the month totaled \$18,263.66. Baade motioned to pass Res. 2-2022 T.O.F, Radloff-Schneider second, carried unanimously.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and place for the public hearing and meeting on the matter of the FY2023 Max Tax Levy at 7:05 pm. The Mayor then asked the Clerk whether any written objections had been filed by any City resident or property owner to the proposal. The Clerk advised the Mayor and the Council that no written objections had been filed. The Mayor then called for oral objections to the proposal and none were made. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the time for receiving oral and written objections to be closed. Steege motioned to pass Res. 2.1.2022 Max Tax Levy, Radloff-Schneider second, carried unanimously. Roll call vote: AYES 5, NAYS 0. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the measure duly adopted. Steege motioned to set public

hearing for FY2023 Budget for March 3, 2022, at 7pm, Boddicker second, carried unanimously.

Administrator Humble informed council that due to unforeseen internal delays, SOO Green did not return the counter-signed and accepted franchise to Luana within the 30-day window stated in

Section 1.014 of the franchise approved in December 2020. SOO Green requests that the City pass a new ordinance issuing a franchise for the SOO Green project. SOO Green apologized for the inconvenience of issuing a new franchise but believes this will ensure that the appropriate franchising rights are in place for the project. SOO Green will reimburse the City for all publication costs, attorneys fees and any other expenses associated with the franchising process. Olson motioned to set public hearing for Municipal Franchise- SOO Green HVDC Link Project for March 3, 2022, at 7pm, Steege second, car-

ried unanimously. Next regular Council meeting will be held March 3, 2022, at 7:00 pm. Mayor Schroeder adjourned the meeting at 7:40 pm.
