KCRG does look to have three corporate sponsors for the segment, however, even if they have none, one or two they are still doing the segment. They will start shooting stories on May 9th and the "Our Town" segment that features Luana, Monona, and Postville will air the week of June 6th to 9th on the 6:00 a.m. news. KCRG will then continue with more coverage on the 4 and 6 p.m. newscasts. They will do one Facebook post per day.
