**RESOLUTION #15-2022  
STOP SIGN REMOVAL IRON-  
WOOD ROAD**  
WHEREAS, the Board of Super-visors of Clayton County is empow-ered under authority of Sections 321.236, 321.255, and 321.345 of the Code of Iowa to control STOP signs at specified entrances there-to, and  
WHEREAS, it has been deter-mined that Ironwood Road is a through road,  
WHEREAS, it has been determined that at the intersection of Ironwood Road and 250th St, the traffic shall stop on 250th St, and be through traffic on Ironwood Road,  
WHEREAS, the Board of Super-visors of Clayton County desires to make the following change to the road stop situation:  
Remove the stop sign on Iron-wood Road at the intersection with 250th Street in Section 15, Read Township, T-93N, R-4W, Clayton County, Iowa  
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RE-SOLVED, by the Board of Super-visors of Clayton County that the above described road has a STOP sign removed for the convenience, safety, and welfare of the traveling public at the noted secondary road

intersection. This will become effec-tive June 6, 2022.
